Stunning collection of rare antique clocks to feature at NEC

A striking collection of antique English wall clocks dating back to the 18th Century will be main feature at this autumn's Antiques for Everyone fair being held at the NEC between 29th October and 1st November 2009.

The collection includes antique Tavern clocks, Striking Dial clocks, and early Silver Dialled clocks. It will also include important examples from private collections which have not been seen in public for over 35 years.

John Yealland, the fair's antique clock expert said: "Clocks are such an important part of our every day life nowadays, but in the early 18th century they were a prestigious possession only accessible to the wealthy."

The English Wall Clock feature is just one of the highlights at the fair which is home to an amazing range of items, sold by more than 350 specialist dealers hailing from across the country. With objects totaling more than £20m on display, visitors can browse fine period furniture, pottery, glass, sculpture, jewellery, fashion, arts and crafts, all of which are datelined and vetted by a team of experts.

Visitors looking to spend a little or a lot can browse everything from Victorian novelties for £10 to the finest paintings worth more than £100,000, making Antiques for Everyone a great day out for collectors and enthusiasts alike.

The Antiques for Everyone fair will take place at the NEC from the 29th October to the 1st November 2009. Admission will be £10 when purchased in advance or £12 on the day and includes free parking and a visitor guide.
